

Two Men Fall From Scaffolding, Prompting Comment From Personal Injury Lawyer

The Bureau of Labor Statistics reported that in 72 percent of workers that were injured in scaffolding accidents, the accident was caused either by the planking or support giving way, the employee slipping, or being struck by a falling object.
