?NHTSA recently reported that distracted driving deaths increased by about 8.2 percent from 2014 to 2015,? Feldman said. ?That bad news got even worse with NHTSA?s release on October 4, 2016 of its estimate of 2016 fatalities. According to NHTSA, 2016 has seen a 10.2% increase in fatalities over 2015. Now more than ever, we have to be diligent in spreading the word about safe driving. Unless we commit to safer driving we will lose more children, sisters and brothers, parents, spouses and friends. We need to act now.?
