made as an educator.

online, either for fulltime or part time employment. Internet Income Jamaica has been a pioneer behind the

local movement, successfully training hundreds of people from all across the island how to make money

online since 2013.

The speech made by Young at the press launch of the Small Business Marketing Event served to get patrons

acquainted with the world of online entrepreneurship, ahead of presentations made by Alicia and Lorette

Lyttle at the main event. The sisters, who also hosted a special workshop at the Global Entrepreneurship

Week event for business leaders, spoke to entrepreneurs and students about the importance of social media

and internet marketing.
