Obesity

Data shows that 54% of dogs in The United States are obese. Obese dogs have a shorter lifespan and face an increased risk of arthritis, diabetes, high blood pressure, kidney disease, certain cancers, and heart & respiratory disease.

Diabetes

The climb in reported incidents of canine diabetes is likely tied to the rise of the obesity epidemic. Chances of prevention increase dramatically by maintaining an ideal body weight through prescribing scientifically formulated nutritional products. Canine diabetes can be treated; management involves injecting insulin once or twice daily under the skin and monitoring response to treatment.

Hot Spots

Commonly known as hot spots, the medical term for this bacterial skin infection is acute moist dermatitis. These bare, inflamed, red areas are very uncomfortable and irritating to a pet and usually cause the dog to scratch or chew the affected area. Dogs that are not groomed regularly and have matted dirty coats can be prone to developing hot spots.
