"Their West Coast tour is always on my concert calendar," said Eliason. "They never fail to provide a captivating night of music."

The duo, along with Breene's husband violinist Robert Schumitzky, forms the Aviara Trio, which recently performed at the Bend Church along NW Bond St. This time, Eliason would have to drive all the way to the Friends of the Rancho Bernardo Library at 17110 Bernardo Center Drive for their concert on the 28th, which starts at 6:15 p.m.

The concert, part of a series of classical music concerts, is free and open to the public. Free-will donations for the musicians are encouraged. It will be held in the second-floor community room.

The duo will perform several compositions, including Robert Schumann's "Adagio and Allegro," originally written for horn and piano but adapted for cello and piano; Johannes Brahms' "1st Sonata for Cello and Piano in E minor"; and Astor Piazzolla's "Le Grand Tango for Cello and Piano."

Irawati said she and Breene would also perform a couple of other, smaller pieces, including Sergei Rachmaninov's "Oblivion," but the compositions by Schumann, Brahms and Piazzolla will form the "main course" of the concert.
