For instance, one video shows the students as they role play an emergency and provide CPR to a person who has collapsed. In another set of videos, they show American Heart Association (AHA) instructors performing CPR in an AED Frisco TX Heartsaver CPR course.

Another set of videos show dramatic footage of the use of CPR being used to save lives. In one video, it is showing how CPR was used to save a person who got drowned. He was a 26-year old boy and he was not breathing and considered clinically dead when they started CPR. After a few minutes of CPR, they used a defibrillator and he started breathing again. Nevertheless, he still had to be brought to the hospital because of water in the lungs.

In another video, it is shown how lifeguards saved the life of another drowned man. They didn?t know how long he was under the water and they immediately applied a defibrillator and performed CPR. It was only after the third shock from the defibrillator that a response from the patient was noted. There had been no pulse and he was not breathing for about 5 minutes before he was finally revived. It was also learned later on that the patient had a heart attack. Once again this showed how CPR and the use of an AED can save lives.

The founder of CPR Training Nurse had been a nurse aide before she became a nurse. While she was working as a nurse for two doctors, she was able to gain experience in performing various tests for patients, from blood test and x-rays to heart monitoring and stress testing. Later, she worked in home health and that was when she got exposed to CPR and realized how important CPR is in saving lives.
