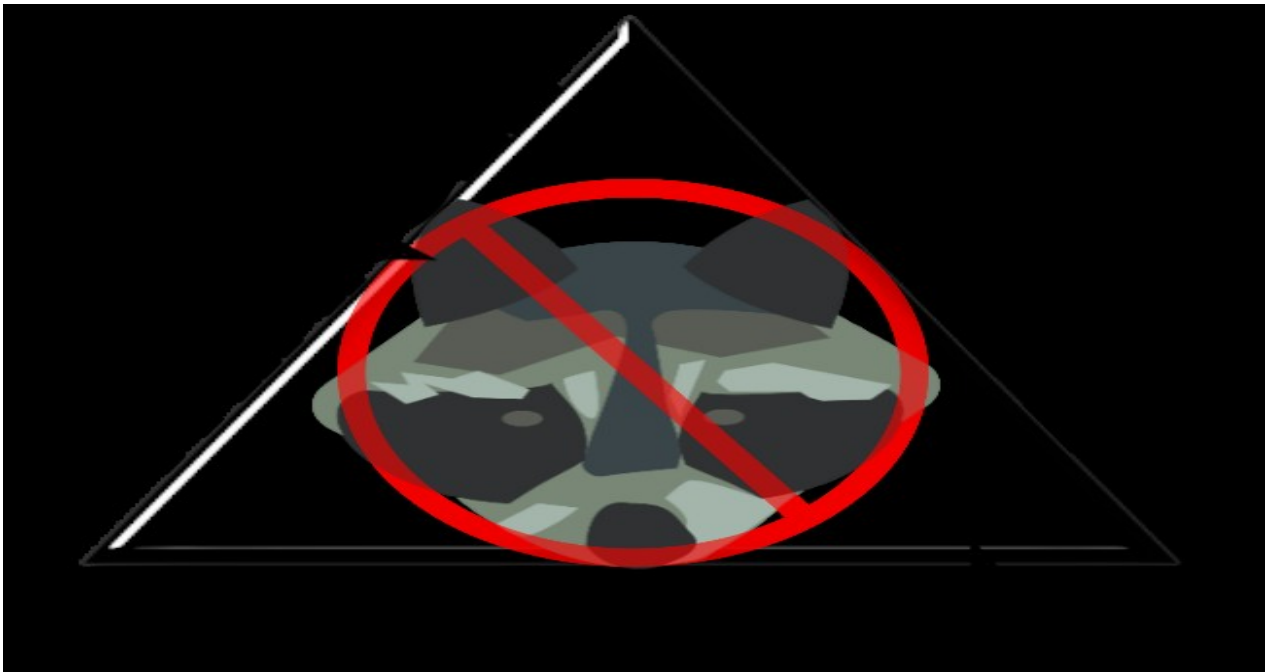




## **Raleigh Bat Removal Company Warns Of Dangers Of Bats In The Attic**

The company spokesperson states, "We highly advise any homeowners that find bat guano to resist sweeping the droppings, as both sweeping and vacuuming them without the correct filtration, can be very dangerous as the airborne spores are spread and can be inhaled. Bat droppings removal is a very specialized process that should only be done by professionals."

The biggest concern about bats is rabies. While only a small percentage of bats actually have rabies, just remember one thing: all it takes is one unsafe contact with a bat or a bat bite, and it becomes a race to preserve a life. On the other hand, almost all of human cases of rabies are caused by bat bites.

Tad Bassett, a spokesperson for Triangle Wildlife Removal & Pest Control, Inc. says, "Bats in an attic can pose dangers to people and pets in many ways. Bats can scratch and bite transmitting rabies, a fatal disease. Bat droppings are also a concern, as bat droppings carry toxic spores that cause the histoplasmosis infection, that can also be fatal."

That is just the tip of the iceberg. With all of these concerns, it should be obvious that a person should never try to handle bats themselves in an attempt to remove them. 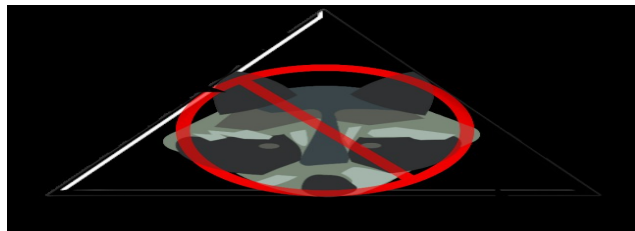
