An important service provided at the Gastro Center NJ is colonoscopy, which can detect various diseases, including IBS, ulcerative colitis, Crohn's disease, colon cancer, polyps, celiac disease, IBD, and more. Colonoscopy may also help find the causes of certain symptoms like lower abdominal pain, rectal bleeding, incontinence, cramps, anemia, unusual bowel habits, weight loss, and long-lasting diarrhea.

Colonoscopy is often used for colon cancer screening. The procedure will usually last from 20 to 30 minutes. However, the patient will need to commit at least three hours at the clinic because of the need to prepare and then recover.

Meanwhile, the specialists at Gastro Center NJ may also perform other kinds of tests. These include hemorrhoid banding, flexible sigmoidoscopy, capsule endoscopy, anorectal manometry, esophageal manometry, and infrared laser.

Upper endoscopy or EGD is used when the symptoms indicate abnormalities in the stomach, esophagus and first portion of the duodenum. These are all part of the upper digestive tract. EGD is usually performed as an outpatient service but sometimes it is done at the hospital or in the emergency ward to look for conditions like bleeding in the upper digestive tract and to treat them.

EGD is often recommended for patients experiencing heartburn, pain in the abdomen or chest, trouble swallowing, bleeding, weight loss, nausea, vomiting, or anemia. EGD is much more reliable and much more accurate compared to x-rays for diagnosing problems. Polyps can be identified and immediately removed during an upper endoscopy and biopsies may be obtained for testing. Any obstructions can be removed and bleeding in these areas can also be stopped.
