



Bail Bond Agents in Tuscaloosa Share How a Bail Bond is Determined

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Tuscaloosa, Ala. — Bail bond agents in Tuscaloosa share with the public how a bail bond is determined. Alabama Bail Bonds breaks down the process in order to help Tuscaloosa residents find the right bail bond agent.

When a judge is determining bail, there are a few factors to be considered. The bail is usually set during the first court appearance of the defendant, commonly on the same day as the arrest or on the next available business day. Alabama Bail Bonds writes, "A lawyer is not typically required to be present, but depending on the severity of the crime, it may be wise to consider having one present to negotiate a reduced amount or one even to be offered."

The bail amount determined by the judge considers main factors such as "the severity of the crime, whether or not the defendant has employment, the defendant's prior criminal history, whether the defendant has close ties to relatives and the community, and whether or not they may be a danger to the community," according to the Tuscaloosa bail bond agents.

The judge determining the bail does have the power to raise, lower, deny or waive the bail. If the judge decides to release the defendant on recognizance (otherwise known as R.O.R.), bail or a bail bond agent is not needed.

Alabama Bail Bonds shares a disclaimer: "While these are the standard things a court will look at, there will be variations between state to state, the accused crime and the individual themselves."
