The first question the company addresses is what bail means. Bail is the monetary value that is required to release a person, known as a defendant, from jail. The bail amount can be paid with cash, or with collateral like property or other possessions. Posting bail will release the defendant from jail but they are still required to appear in court when scheduled to do so. If a defendant cannot post bail for whatever reason, they will simply remain in jail until their court hearing.

Second, clients have asked how a bail amount is determined. Every bail amount is unique because many factors can affect it. This makes the bail amount difficult to predict. The defendant's criminal record, the crime committed, and the defendant's ability to pay are all factors in determining bail. In some cases, a judge will decide to deny the defendant bail. This means the defendant will have to stay in jail until their court hearing. Judges normally deny bail when there is evidence that the defendant will not show up for their court

appointment.

Finally, the Tuscaloosa bail bonds company explained what defendants can do if they cannot post bail. This is where Alabama Bail Bonds comes in. The company states, "In cases where the defendant cannot afford to pay the full amount of bail on his or her own, the defendant may opt to work with a bail bonding company to pay for the bail. A bail bonding company will give the court the amount of the bail that has been set in exchange for a percentage of the total cost of the bail. In turn, the bail bonding company will stand in for the defendant for the entire amount of bail with the court."
