ketamine IV treatments. Some people may become slightly disoriented or be sensitive to light and sound, and the clinic takes precautions to ensure patients are safe during and after treatment and that any possible effects are mitigated as much as possible. This includes making sure that patients do not attempt to drive themselves home after treatment.

For people who hear about Ketamine therapy and wonder ?how much does it cost??, Balance Ketamine Clinics has the answer. Appointments with Balance Ketamine Clinics cost \$500, including all services. Ketamine infusions have not been approved by the FDA and are not covered by insurance, but Balance Ketamine Clinics still bills insurance for the attention of a doctor during the infusion process and the insertion of an IV for the infusion. As such, patients of Balance Ketamine Clinics are generally responsible for \$200 per infusion, to cover the cost of the Ketamine. There are also other options available for other amounts of money depending on the needs of the patient, which may cost more or less than \$200.

One of the services offered by Balance Ketamine Clinics is Ketamine Assisted Psychotherapy, which combines ketamine with the known benefits of a therapeutic relationship. Adding talk therapy to ketamine therapy gives patients the chance to think about their experiences with ketamine therapy, and process them in a healthy and supportive environment. Many life experiences can affect how people experience their lives, which can also be shaped by struggles with mental illnesses such as PTSD and depression. People who experience these kinds of challenges often seek the help of a psychotherapist to help them process and understand their lives.
