The Tungsten Bugger is an important supply for streamer fishing, which is a very effective style of fishing as long as you have the right supplies. These are guaranteed fish catchers and will boost your streamer fishing performance."

Fly fishing is an interesting sport and hobby as it allows a person to get close to nature and enjoy the kind of peace that one can feel from nature. And yet, it also provides a challenge, which is to outsmart the fish, using

basic gear like a fly rod, a fly reel, a fly fishing line, and several flies. Arguably, the flies are the most important because they are the bait for the fish. There are three main kinds of flies, which are dry flies, streamers, and nymphs. Dry flies are the most common and are made to resemble flying insects that land and float on the water. Nymphs are made to look like aquatic creatures, mostly larvae, and usually float at or just below the surface of the water. Streamers also resemble aquatic life but are bigger than nymphs and they are the fly equivalent of lures. Patuxent Signature Flies has posted several articles about nymphs and flies and these can be gleaned from this post.

The Tungsten Bugger 6 Pack contains six streamers that are tied on Firehole Sticks 839 with tungsten beads. They are particularly useful for deep streamer fishing. Often times trout will be holding to the stream bottom rather than higher in the water column. It's times like this that require a heavier fly to get down to where the fish are.

Aside from streamer supplies, Patuxent Signature Flies also offers other kinds of flies, including euro nymphs, nymphs, light tackle, freshwater, and saltwater. They offer other kinds of nymphs, such as the San Juan Worm, Greasy Goods, and the Patuxent Pack. They also offer leaders, particularly the Euro Leader, and also light tackles, particularly the Bunker Buster.

They offer various kinds of freshwater fishing flies, which include the Tungsten Bugger 6 Pack. Other flies in this category include the Jiggy Squirrel 3 Pack, the Balanced Bugger, the San Juan Worm, the Greasy Goods, the Patuxent Pack, the Meat Whistle, the Hair Wing Streamer, the Pine Squirrel Streamer, and the Bunker Buster. They also offer several flies under the saltwater fishing category. These include the Panfish Candy, the Half & Half Clouser, and the Shad Dazzler.

Sean Beck explains that he had observed consistent success when using various styles of flies that he was making back in 2017. That was the time that he decided to establish Patuxent Signature Flies in order to share his successes with other anglers. Mostly, he and his fly fishing friends had experienced a lot of success with flies that have subsurface patterns and he produces flies that are of this type.
