With regards to foot and ankle deformities, they offer surgical treatment alternatives including ankle deformities, Haglund?s deformity, Pes cavus, ankle instability, hammertoes, posterior tibial tendon dysfunction, brachymetatarsia, mallet toes, post traumatic deformity, bunion, osteomyelitis, sesamoiditis, Charcot arthropathy, overlapping or underlapping toes, spurs, claw toe, peroneal tendon dislocation/dysfunction, tarsal coalition, and flatfeet.

For sports medicine podiatry services, Essex Union Podiatry offers treatment options for various conditions. These include athlete?s foot, fractures, achilles tendonitis, heel fissures, bunions, overuse injuries, calluses, sprains, flatfeet, and strains. With regards to general podiatry, they offer various services. These include athlete?s foot treatment, nail and wart surgery, second opinion services, emergency care of foot and ankle trauma, non-invasive peripheral arterial testing, shock wave treatment of Achilles tendinosis and heel pain, foot odor treatments, pain management, gait analysis and orthotic fabrication, plantar fasciitis, toenail infection treatment, heel pain treatment, radiology services with certified foot and ankle imaging technicians, ultrasound imaging of the foot and ankle, ingrown toenails treatment, worker?s compensation, laser nail fungus treatment, and wound care.

They also provide a number of services at affiliated facilities. These include ankle replacement surgery, foot and ankle surgery, shock wave treatment under sedation, arthroscopic surgery, laser surgery, wound care, endoscopic surgery, and platelet-rich plasma (PRP) therapy.

Essex Union Podiatry also provides complete care for traumatic injury of the foot or ankle arising from various situations, such as household accident, injury during participation in sports training or high-contact sport, motor vehicle accident, and injury sustained at work. The conditions they can treat include burns, pain and swelling, cast or wound dressing problems, sports and overuse injuries, dislocations, strains and sprains, and fractures.

Another important category that Essex Union Podiatry can focus on is diabetic care. This is because patients with diabetes have a higher risk for foot conditions as a result of peripheral neuropathy, which is the result of damage to the nerves in the legs and feet. Because of this nerve damage, diabetic patients have less ability to detect extreme temperatures and pain. This results in possible foot injury or infection that the patient is unaware of. The offer regular and comprehensive examinations for patients with diabetes who have peripheral neuropathy. As part of this, they check for high blood pressure and areas with poor circulation, including noticeable changes in the foot, such as change in skin color, broken skin, or swelling.

Essex Union Podiatry also offers medical care for various types of wounds of the foot or ankle. These include abrasions, incisions, lacerations, punctures, and avulsions. For pediatric podiatry services, they offer specialized services because the bones of children are different from the bones of adults. Rather than fully formed bones, children have soft caps at the growth plates, made of cartilage. This will ultimately be replaced by bones but in the mean time, foot and ankle conditions in children have to be treated in a different manner compared to adults.
