Much like a rear-view mirror on a car, the Take A Look mirror allows cyclists to see what's behind them. While

some cyclists argue they could "turn their head," Lund disagrees. "Defensive riding and awareness could

mean the difference between an accident and near-miss."

Lund adds that "in those situations, you don't have time to turn your head."
