Each of them is highly trained in a wide range of specialties that can fit the specific individual needs of children, adolescents, and adults. They have decades of combined experience and apply the most up-to-date tools and technologies for both surgical and non-surgical treatment alternatives.

Their specialties at Essex Union Podiatry are: foot and ankle deformity correction; general podiatry; sports medicine podiatry services; diabetic care; trauma care; wound care; and pediatric podiatry services. They offer surgical treatment for various kinds of deformities. These include: ankle deformities; ankle instability; brachymetatarsia or short toes; bunion; Charcot arthropathy; claw toe; clubfoot; flatfoot; Haglund's deformity; hammertoes; mallet toes; osteomyelitis; overlapping or underlapping toes; peroneal tendon dislocation; pes cavus; posterior tibial tendon dysfunction; post traumatic deformity; sesamoiditis; spurs; and tarsal coalition. They are able to provide treatment for various conditions. These include bone conditions, muscle conditions, poor circulation, skin conditions, tendons and ligaments conditions, and various other conditions. Bone conditions that they can provide treatment for include: arthritic conditions such as osteoarthritis; bone spurs; bunions; calcaneus fractures; hallux rigidus; hammertoes; mallet toes; osteochondritis dissecans; pilon fractures; sesamoiditis; shin splints; stress fractures; tailor's bunion or bunionette; tarsal coalition; and vertical talus.

Poor circulation conditions may also be treated through non-surgical and minimally invasive surgical procedures at Essex Union Podiatry. These include acrocyanosis; chilblains or cold feet; erythromelalgia; infections; ischemic foot; peripheral arterial disease; sores; and venous stasis.

Essex Union Podiatry also offers a number of surgical and non-surgical treatment options for various skin conditions. These include: allergies; athlete's foot or tinea pedis; blisters; burning feet; calluses; corns; cysts; eczema; foot odor; frostbite; fungus; gangrene; heel fissures; lesions; psoriasis; swelling; ulcers; and warts.

They also offer a broad range of surgical and minimally invasive non-surgical treatments for ligament and tendon conditions of the foot and ankle. These include Achilles tendonitis; ankle instability; flatfoot or overpronation; plantar fasciitis; posterior tibial tendon dysfunction; and strains and sprains.

They also offer a number of treatment options for other conditions of the foot and lower extremity. These include: bursitis; clubfoot; edema; fungal nails; ganglion cysts; high arch foot; ingrown toenails; Morton's neuromas; nail injuries and infections; plantar hyperhidrosis; subungual exostosis; toenail infection; and diabetic wounds.

Dr. Jason Galante, DPM, FACFAS, FACFAOM, is a double board certified foot and ankle surgeon. He is double board certified by the American Board of Podiatric Medicine and the American Board of Foot and Ankle Surgery.
