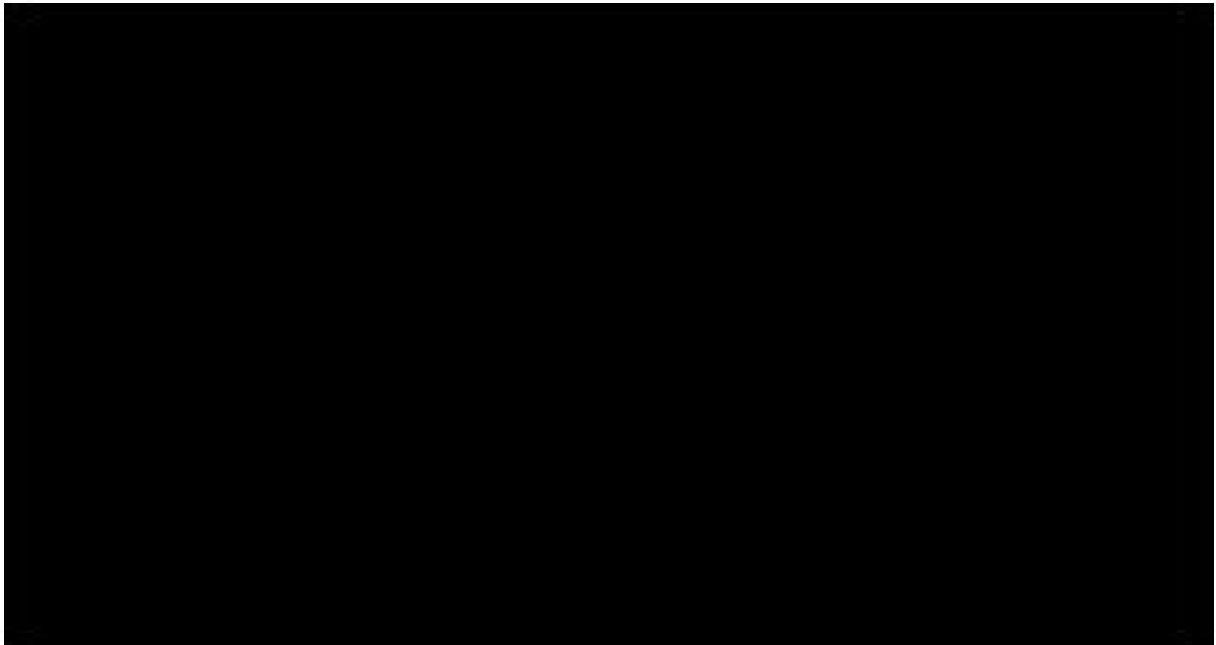




Mark Cox Woodworking Announces that Their Laser Engraving Services Are Now Open to the Public

detailed Pittsburgh Steelers emblem that was done on a set of drink coasters. Cox says that sports logos are one of the most requested types of engravings that he does. He also said he has been asked to do engravings on everything from cutting boards to iPhones. The company can even engrave items with custom logos or designs that have been submitted to them. According to the owner, this type of engraving service has the ability to make an item totally unique and unforgettable.

Cox says that one of the more interesting facts about his laser engraving process is that it's not limited to just being done on wood. It can also be performed on metal, tile, and other hard surfaces. He has engraved boxes, coasters, leather items, and even aluminum business cards. Those who have an item they want to be engraved by him but are not sure if it can be done, simply have to send him a photo of that item from the top and side views. The company owner will then give them a response as to whether he can do that engraving job or not. Cox also stated that his diode laser works on a 12"x12" platform, so for engraving patterns that need to be larger than that it requires him to use his CNC machine to do the job.

The information page on their laser engraving services also displayed several photos showing examples of the company's laser engraving efforts. These pictures included ones that showed highly detailed engravings that were done on drink coasters, boxes, and metal business cards. There were also some photos of custom laser engravings that had been done on more unique items such as Christmas tree ornaments, leather belts, and on the handles of such items as bottle openers. Cox says he posted these photos on the website to give customers inspiration as to the possibilities that the company's laser engraving services offer them. The laser engraving service page even listed some popular engraving categories they are often asked to do. This list included engravings that feature plant life, symbols, special occasions, and even animals.

The owner went on to say that their laser engraving services nicely compliment their well-established CNC wood carving services. He says that many times if one engraving project cannot be done using one of these engraving methods it often can be completed using the other. Cox mentioned that they also offer another etching and engraving service that is primarily used for making logos and designs on acrylic, glass, or metal.
