The article explains that generally speaking, there are two types of flat roof repair. These types are: thermoplastic olefin (TPO) and ethylene propylene diene terpolymer (EPDM). These two types share a lot of characteristics and yet have different attributes.

The blog post they published gives comparisons and contrasts between the materials. For example, EPDM is available for as low as \$0.4 a square foot. EPDM is a single-ply membrane and thus it is durable and relatively easy to install. EPDM is particularly valued for the fact that it is 100% recyclable. These days being 'Eco-friendly' is something that all businesses should consider if it is possible to do so. Another reason why this material is often chosen is that it has marked longevity. EPDM can be relied on for lasting in the neighborhood of about 40 years. By any measure, that's a sound investment.

TPO, on the other hand, is more expensive but many business owners prefer it because it can be color-coordinated to their business. Cox Roofing Systems, a very successful and well-respected contractor in

Not every roof can accept that due to the weight that the structure would have to support.

This post also illustrated some other ways to attach single ply roofing like TPO or EPDM. High on that list is mechanically-fastened roofing. These are always recommended in areas that are prone to hurricanes and/or heavy thunderstorms. Another way that is possible is to use the "fully adhered" approach which basically means that the roofing material is fully glued down to the structure below. When it is done properly, the roof actually becomes fully waterproofed. Many people feel that this approach is actually the easiest way to make a roof look exceptionally good.

TPO also helps keep a building cooler in the summer because it helps repel UV rays. This can help lower the need for cooling equipment which can save utility costs tremendously.
