This preparation included the purchase of critical equipment, including N95 and KN95 masks, which filter out 95% of airborne particles down to .3 microns. They also installed three types of ultraviolet air sterilization equipment and hospital-grade, anti-microbial air filtration, all designed to kill viruses upon contact. All staff is antibody tested weekly with a rapid response test. Altogether, these precautionary measures created a Medical Safe Zone, a facility designed to treat patients in the safest manner possible.

?We are adhering to the standard glove and mask-wearing, extensive disinfecting, and social distancing, but we felt those measures alone weren?t enough to keep our clients safe. We felt the need to go beyond those measures, particularly given the airborne nature of the virus. This is why we have created the only Medical Safe Zone for Physical Therapy Care or Chiropractic care in the State of New Jersey,? says Dr. Gary Struble, President Emeritus.

In many parts of the country, patients have put non-emergency medical care on hold for the past few months, causing further injuries or suffering from being sedentary due to social distancing requirements.
