In addition to providing chiropractic treatment in Glendale and surrounding areas, Unity Spine & Joint can also provide other kinds of treatments. For instance, they can provide trigger point injections. Trigger points emerge when a little knot of muscle is developed when a muscle has been injured or overworked. The result is pain in the general area of the affected muscle. It may also result into referred pain, which is connected to various areas of the body because the trigger point happens to be sitting on or near a nerve. Trigger point injections are usually safe low-dose steroids with some local anesthetic. The steroid will cause the inflammation to subside, and once this is done, physiotherapy and massage therapy may be used to get rid of the pain and rehabilitate the muscle fibers.

Meanwhile, chiropractic therapy is a safe and effective treatment that may help in reducing pain, inflammation, and damage to musculoskeletal systems. This can be used for various kinds of pain, such as: upper back pain, lower back pain, neck pain, shoulder pain, hip pain, knee pain, sciatic pain, and bulging/herniated disc. The focus of this kind of therapy is to balance the spine in order to stabilize nearby groups and joints. With an aligned spine and balanced body, the ability of the body to heal itself will be naturally restored and the effectiveness of the nervous system will be enhanced.

Joint injections may also be offered for the purpose of decreasing inflammation of tissue found in the joint's space. Points for joint injections are the shoulders, wrists, elbows, knees, and fingers. A local anesthetic is injected first to numb the skin and prevent patient discomfort.

Epidural steroid injections use a combination of a local anesthetic and corticosteroids. Corticosteroids are effective in reducing inflammation to relieve the pain resulting from pressure on spinal nerve roots. Epidurals are only given when other non-surgical treatment alternatives have failed to relieve the pain in the neck, back, arms, and legs. Conditions where epidurals may be used include spinal stenosis, disc herniation, spondylolysis, sciatica, and degenerative discs.
