



Senior Care Center Reports on the Status of COVID 19 Vaccinations in Hayward CA

Senior Care Center Hayward wants to inform people about the status of COVID 19 vaccinations in the Hayward, CA area, which is part of Alameda County. As of February 8, 2021, 96,805 doses have been redistributed or allocated to the healthcare partners of the Alameda County Health Care Services Agency Public Health Department to administer. The Public Health Department has received 45,945 doses and has administered 30,662 doses as of February 6. For additional information on this, people may want to contact their healthcare provider. The public health department is currently focusing on the members of the Phase 1a group, who are the healthcare workers, and Phase 1b group members, who are seniors aged 65 and above, and members of the education and child care, emergency services, and food/agriculture sectors.

Meanwhile, a new large scale COVID 19 vaccination site is set to open on February 16 at the Oakland Coliseum, which will be used for Alameda County's phased vaccination rollout. This vaccination site will be run by the California Office of Emergency Services and the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

Healthcare systems in Alameda County, including Hayward, regularly update their eligibility criteria based on their capacity and the availability of the vaccine. Those who are interested to know how and when they can

have the vaccine may want to contact their healthcare provider.

Each assisted living facility will be different from the others according to the amenities offered. However, they will all provide assistance to senior residents with regards to the performance of their daily living tasks, including bathing, feeding, toileting, dressing, grooming, walking, and more. Thus, seniors who have challenges with doing certain daily activities, especially when it comes to mobility, may want to become a resident of an assisted living facility. Amenities that are often provided by assisted living facilities include: laundry, dining service, social programs and events, personal care, housekeeping, and emergency and security services.

There are also other kinds of senior care homes that are available, depending on the needs of the seniors. Memory care homes are for seniors with dementia or Alzheimer's disease, providing them with the required medical care and assistance with daily living tasks. A prevalent support system is typically present in a memory care home that provides help for the residents' personal care requirements like eating, bathing, toileting, grooming, personal hygiene, dressing, taking their required medication, and other daily living routine tasks. Those who are recommended to become residents of memory care homes are not just those who have been diagnosed with Alzheimer's but also those with different types of dementia, such as vascular dementia, frontotemporal dementia, dementia with Lewy bodies, Pick's disease, Korsakoff syndrome, Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease, mixed dementia, and normal pressure hydrocephalus. Memory care homes typically have the same amenities as assisted living facilities, except for the addition of therapy programs for memory loss and medical assistance.

For seniors who have other healthcare issues and required 24-hour personal care and medical care services, nursing homes are recommended. These facilities are most appropriate for those need intensive medical attention and cannot be cared for at home, such as those who have a chronic illness or those who are recovering from injuries. Amenities may include physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy, medical monitoring, around-the-clock medical care, and medical resources, in addition to the usual amenities.
