Very Large Tree Removal Cost

Trees standing at 80+ feet cost between \$1,100 and \$1,800 to remove. This is understandable considering that huge trees require more sophisticated equipment and more experienced personnel. Some of the trees that feature a height of above 80 feet include:

- Pine, standing at 80 to 100 feet tall
- Tulip, with an average height of 70 to 90 feet

How Soon Can You Cut Down a Tree?

A wide range of reasons can necessitate the removal of a tree. The most common reasons include:

- Dead or Dying Tree**
Dead trees often turn into eyesores. Getting rid of these types of trees can help improve your property's appearance.
- Obstructed View**
If the tree is making your driveway less visible, investing in the tree's removal may be a good idea. Removing the tree will help reduce the chances of an accident.
- Safety Hazard**
Storms do destabilize trees and turn them into safety hazards. If this is the case with a tree close to your home, you should invest in its removal as soon as possible.
- Damage to Utilities**
Tree roots are known to cause damage to underground utilities. Some roots may even damage your home's foundation. To fix these issues, considering tree removal may be a good idea.

How Much Does Tree Service Cost in Alabaster?

The tree service cost in Alabaster varies depending on the type of service you want. Since we have already looked at the tree removal cost, below we will look at the average cost of other tree services:

- Tree Trimming and Pruning Cost**
Hiring a professional to trim/prune a single tree can cost anywhere between \$80 and \$1,000+, with the typical price range being \$250 to \$500. Expect \$80 for your small tree, \$175 for the medium-sized tree, and about \$250 to \$1,000 for a tree featuring a height of over 50 feet.
- Note:** Things like diseases, accessibility, pests, etc. can also affect the tree trimming cost significantly.
- Stump Removal Cost**
The average stump removal cost ranges between \$60 and \$350 per stump depending on various factors such as accessibility, type of tree, and most importantly, stump size. If you have a large stump featuring extensive roots on your property, you should expect the complete stump removal cost to be on the higher end.
- If the cost of completely removing the stump is out of your affordable range, you can opt to grind the stump. In Alabaster, stump grinding costs an average of \$100 to \$150. The per diameter inch cost ranges between \$2 and \$4.
- Arborist Service Cost**
If you need the arborist to help with trimming a small palm tree, \$75 can get the job done. If, however, the arborist has to help with the removal of a 100-year-old oak tree, the cost can be as high as \$5,000. On average, however, most arborist services will cost between \$375 and \$1,500.
