The methods Dr. Keith uses to maintain, enhance, and restore a smile include:

Porcelain Veneers? These are custom made porcelain shells that cover the front and sides of teeth. This process improves teeth that have large gaps, permanently stained, misshaped, chipped, cracked, or worn down overtime.

Zoom! Whitening ? An in office whitening system that uses hydrogen peroxide and a chair side lamp to reverse discoloration that happens over time from tobacco, medications, or foods and beverages that stain like soda and coffee. The process takes about an hour.

Invisalign? This is one of the types of cosmetic dentistry that improves functionality and health of teeth. It consists of invisible and comfortable clear removable teeth aligners that won?t restrict diet but still work like braces.

Bonding? A resin paste is used to fill in or reshape teeth. It is typically used to for small repairs to cracks,

cavities, chips, broken teeth, or large gaps. It also protects teeth roots after gums recede. It typically takes

less than an hour.

Implants? Dental implants are replacements for missing teeth that are fully functional and indistinguishable

from real teeth. Implants are quickly becoming popular because of how reliable and convenient they are.

Smile Makeovers? This make over addresses any issues that are seen during a smile and the best option to

increasing confidence.

Full Mouth Rehabilitation? This method of restoration can fix every single issue from a missing tooth and

whitening to just about anything.
