need to be replaced; apply OxyPrep and let this sit on the wood for several minutes; apply OxyPar and allow

the foam to help in bringing the residual organic contaminants to the surface; and finally, wipe off the wooden

surface.

structural repair or replacement. They are specialists in the repair and replacement of wood components

damaged because of rot, pests, warping, mold, or other circumstances such as floods or fires. They would
