Smart devices are able to do a lot of tasks, but the post raises the question of whether or not people are taking full advantage of the smart devices that are available on the market. Home automation can decrease a person's or family's yearly home operating costs by an average of 10%. Not only can a person save money with smart devices, but they will also waste less energy. In fact, Americans spend \$130 billion dollars on energy waste. So, while a person's smart devices cannot save them money on their entertainment, rent or mortgage, the implementation of home automation could lead to savings in unavoidable costs, such as the utility bills. The more devices one may have in the home, the more money one will save. One of the smart devices that can be beneficial is a Smart Thermostat. They function beyond the scope of programmable thermostats, as smart thermostats are capable of optimizing a home's heating and cooling processes. A smart thermostat will adapt to a person's daily routines and stop warm or cold air that is being sent to rooms or spaces that are not in use at certain times. The smart thermostat can be controlled by an internet-connected device, which means one can control the thermostat even when not at home.

Smart Security is another example of this technology. If one outfits the home with smart security systems like security cameras, spotlight cameras or video doorbells, one may be surprised at the potential to save money. Systems like RING, Wink or Nest can be merged with other smart home devices to be controlled by voice commands to a virtual assistant already in the home, as well as via one's own voice commands or from a smartphone, automation hub or computer/tablet. Smart security systems help save money as they minimize the risk of theft and break-ins. They can also alert the owner to a sudden drop in the temperature of their home, which may protect them from frozen pipes that lead to floods. A smart security system will turn lights on for the owner at a predetermined time, or one may choose to turn on the lights via a phone or another device ? which reduces the energy consumption of the home. Smart plumbing options like the Flo by Moen and smart valves are also excellent ways to save money on one's water and electricity bills. The smart valve can be voice-activated to perform commands, such as asking it to start the shower when one wants it started. It also compresses the air in the water supply before it reaches the water meter, which means that the owner will not be overcharged. The smart valve also prevents water pressure drops and ensures that the water meter will run in its normal flow range. Finally, the smart valve ensures that the supply will not be overloaded. The Flo by Moen protects the home from water damage and leaks with an alert sent to an automation hub, smartphone or computer/tablet.

Flo can be installed onto existing fixtures and onto pipes and watch for any type of change in pressure and temperature. The owner will be alerted before disaster occurs as The Flo can shut off the system before a leak springs, which can mitigate water damage and the need for restorative work and repairs. Homeowners

may show proof of the smart security and plumbing devices to the insurance company and even save on the homeowner's insurance (as they may be eligible for a lower rate).
