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Each and every year, the national Medicare program loses billions of dollars because of illegal activity committed by individuals and entities that deal with the program. This type of fraud has an effect on every taxpayer and is a significant drain on the Medicare program. The CMS (Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services) contracts with lots of individuals, companies, and organizations that manage Medicare reimbursements and file claims. They need to essentially trust that people and companies remain in compliance with the regulations. Unfortunately, lots of entities are not in compliance, and that number is increasing. Considering the government's shortage of resources to police and hold defrauders liable, the government must often rely on private healthcare employees in the market to come forward with details so they can hold those who defraud the program accountable.

"Fraud against the Medicare program can take many forms," stated Mr. Khurana. "It can include manipulating patient records in order to earn more from Medicare, surcharging the government, providing second-rate healthcare services or products, or many other activities. The government relies on private whistleblowers to come forward with direct knowledge and evidence of dishonest activities and the government rewards the whistleblowers for their important help. Through qui tam suits, whistleblowers have the ability to bring civil claims against those celebrations on behalf of the government under the False Claims Act and can be rewarded for it."

The federal False Claims Act is a federal statute that renders it criminal for any entity to make incorrect Medicare claims or otherwise defraud the government. It additionally enables a healthcare worker with knowledge of fraudulent activity against the Medicare program to file a whistleblower lawsuit on behalf of the federal government. In exchange for their info and effort, the whistleblowers may be entitled to gather rewards of between 15% to 30% of the recovered fund by the federal government. The act likewise has regulations for whistleblower security against any company retaliation that may result from filing a claim or agreeing to a deal with the government.

When a whistleblower steps forward with information and facts regarding Medicare fraud, the case is submitted to a federal district court. It is put 'under seal' while the Department of Justice investigates the claim and the proof, interviews potential witnesses, and seeks advice from professionals and agency personnel. The federal government will then choose if it will step in. If the government does not choose to step in, the whistleblower still may continue the case by themselves.

Because healthcare employees put themselves at risk doing this essential work, the federal False Claims Act highly incentivizes them with a substantial part of the financial recuperation. In a successful claim, the government can recover as much as 3 times its losses to fraudulent activity in addition to penalties for each incident of fraud.
