Since minor mistakes in this paperwork can lead to many major pitfalls, Amundson Law Office recommends having an attorney assist in the process of completing the paperwork to ensure it's done correctly. Once this paperwork has been filed, a person going through a divorce may want to file for temporary support or custody. Every situation is different, but if one spouse, for example, does not have an income, that spouse will often be granted some kind of temporary financial support while the couple works on completing their divorce. Custody is determined on a case-by-case basis where the best interests of the children is taken into consideration before an agreement can be set up. Once the divorce has been filed and temporary support and custody agreements have been arranged, the divorce goes through a "discovery process" where all of the financial documents relevant to the relationship are made available to both parties. This can be helpful in situations where one spouse has been handling all the financial matters of a household and is withholding that information from the other spouse during the divorce. With all of the information in the hands of all parties, it is time to work out the custody and financial issues of the divorce, and Attorney Lisa Amundson will protect her client's rights and pursue the best possible outcomes for their families. The courts will determine the best agreement for the children involved, and a period of negotiations is entered where both parties and their attorneys work out an agreement that both parties can agree on.
