Near pools, they may contaminate the water with their feces or spread diseases like rabies. If they are near fruit trees, they may eat the fruit or damage the tree itself. These troublesome animals can also spread parasites and diseases to other creatures, especially in swampy areas. So, for anyone who might be living in an area where there might be a raccoon infestation, it is very important that they know what kind of damage raccoons can cause.?

In their blog post, Iguana Removal 305 explains that there are many types of damage raccoons can cause to

a home or property. Raccoons are very destructive, and they can cause a lot of damage in a short amount of time. Some of the most common types of damage raccoons cause include tearing up roofing and siding, tipping and raiding garbage cans, contaminating food supplies, tearing up lawns and digging holes, destroying gardens and more. If a racoon gains access to the interior of a property, it can also destroy insulation and tear up ductwork, resulting in thousands of dollars in damage. On top of all that, these animals can also spread diseases to both people and pets via their urine and feces.

If someone suspects raccoons are causing damage to their property, it is important to take action immediately to prevent further damage and stay safe. To this end, Iguana Removal 305 advises that homeowners should be educated on how to detect the presence of raccoons before they cause any long lasting damage.

The blog post explains that the first step in identifying a raccoon problem is inspecting their tracks. Raccoon tracks differ from the tracks of other animals because they have thumb-like appendages. Their front paws are 1 to 1-1/2 inches wide and 2 to 3 inches long, with five toes. The hind feet are about 1 inch wide and 2-1/2 to 4 inches long. Raccoons often follow straight lines when moving from one food source to another or from a den site to a food source.

Another way of identifying raccoon damage is by looking at their droppings. Raccoon droppings are larger than other animal droppings and often contain food particles. The blog post describes raccoon droppings as being ½-inch to one-inch long, and they sometimes contain shells from consumed insects.

If they have managed to cause some harm to a property, common types of damage inside a home can include torn insulation, chewed wires and damaged ceilings. Outside the home, this could mean damaged vegetation, overturned garbage cans and torn shingles. Other types of raccoon damage include depressions in lawns (from collecting rocks and tearing apart wood for nesting materials). More information can be found here: Raccoon Damage Property.
