The lawyer explains that child support is the legal obligation of the parents to make payments towards one another or one parent to the other custodial parent for the financial support of their child or children. The parent who does not have custody of the child usually pays support to the other parent in most cases. This

payment is used for the daily expenses of the child such as childcare, health insurance, education, and others.

Attorney Ryan Besinque adds that a lot of parents usually misunderstand shared custody. A common misconception is that some parents believe that if custody is shared, both parents won't have to pay child support to each other. However, if custody is shared, the parent with the higher income will have to pay child support to the lower-wage earning parent.

According to attorney Ryan Besinque, "Couples can come to agreements outside of the typical scenarios. It is important for divorcing spouses to understand their legal rights and responsibilities before they agree to anything. Once the child support award is in place, there can be serious legal and financial consequences if the father or mother fails in his or her child support responsibilities."
