The lawyer explains that doctors under investigation by the New York Office of Professional Medical Conduct

(OPMC) can face disciplinary actions which can have serious consequences on their careers and ability to practice medicine. The OPMC is responsible for investigating complaints against doctors and other specialist assistants.

Jason Bassett also lists the most common reasons that a healthcare professional might be sanctioned. These reasons include insurance fraud and billing fraud, as well as substance abuse and sexual misconduct. These charges can lead to the suspension or revocation of a healthcare professional's license.

The defense lawyer mentions that the New York State Education Department's Office of Professional Discipline, or OPD, is responsible for investigating misconduct allegations against nurses, dentists, pharmacists, chiropractors, and physical therapists.
