AIMM currently offers 4 Pro Tools Certifications - Avid Certified User: Pro Tools - Pro Tools 101 and Pro Tools 110, Avid Certified User: Pro Tools | Game Audio - Pro Tools 101 and Pro Tools 130, Avid Certified Operator: Pro Tools | Music - Pro Tools 101, Pro Tools 110, Pro Tools 201, and Pro Tools 210M, and Avid Certified Operator: Pro Tools | Post - Pro Tools 101, Pro Tools 110, Pro Tools 201, and Pro Tools 210P.

Fees for a Pro Tools certification and course and the completion exam are set independently by the Avid Learning Partner that an aspirant ends up choosing. They have to purchase a coursebook and other study materials, which includes the cost of certification exams and a single retake if required. Additional retakes are chargeable. However, those that attend AIMM, which is an AVID training partner, will benefit from having their certification costs included in their program's general tuition. Exam results are shown immediately when an exam is completed and submitted for evaluation. Unless a test taker is banned for reasons such as fraud or rule violations, they are allowed unlimited attempts to retake the exam. Students of AIMM are allowed two free attempts due to its status as an AVID training partner. Pro Tools Certification does not expire. However, a successful test taker is only certified for that particular version of the Pro Tools software. Once they've passed, they cannot take the exam again for the same version of the Avid product.
