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Dr. Theo Spyrakis, an expert in implant and restorative dentistry from Sydney, is educating New South Wales residents about the advantages offered by the All-On-4 dental procedure, an advanced minimally invasive technique for implanting teeth.

With the All-On-4 procedure, the upper or lower set of teeth is replaced with just four implants. These four implants act as a support mechanism for the placement of a new set of fixed teeth. The implants are made from titanium metal which is known for its strength and compatibility with human biology. Once the implants are installed the patient has a choice between three separate tiers of teeth namely Basic, Premium, and Titanium Deluxe.

The All-On-4 procedure is particularly appealing because it makes rehabilitation possible for patients who might not have the sufficient bone structure to support conventional dental implants which require 6 to 8 implants to support a full fixed bridge. The All-On-4 technique doesn't require the same density of bone to secure the implant making a full arch rehabilitation possible for this select group of patients who would be out of luck if they relied on conventional dental implant techniques. The All-On-4 procedure succeeds where conventional dental implant procedures fail because the posterior implants are tilted 45° towards the rear of the mouth and placed into the anterior maxilla, a region of the jaw with higher bone density.

Another reason why the All-On-4 procedure is a lifesaver for some patients is that it is the ideal solution for those suffering from osteoporosis, a bone disease characterized by low bone mineral density, low bone mass, or poor bone structure. Patients with osteoporosis who are also suffering from dental issues may have the perception that they can't get their teeth rehabilitated due to their poor-quality bones. While this is true for conventional dental implants, All-On-4 eliminates the need for bone grafting, which means patients suffering from osteoporosis can also reap its benefits.

Dr. Theo Spyrakis talks more about how the All-On-4 procedure can give those suffering from poor dental health a new lease on life by saying, "Not everyone is blessed with immaculate dental health. Moreover, calcium and vitamin D deficiencies can also lead to conditions like osteoporosis that make restoring one's teeth a significant challenge. Thankfully, the genius application of the All-On-4 procedure sidesteps all of that and we have at our disposal a dentistry solution that can help those with even the most unconventional and weakened bone structure get back the perfect use of their teeth.
