Apartment buildings are either multiple dwellings or multi-story dwellings. For plumbing purposes, multi-story buildings are those that are too high to use pressure from the municipal water supply to be able to reach the whole building. Thus, multi-story buildings require systems that can push the water to reach every unit. On the other hand, multiple dwelling apartments can use plumbing systems just like those used for single-family homes.

There are two distinct parts of a plumbing system. One is used to deliver freshwater inside, while the other is used for transporting wastewater away. The freshwater system will need pressure to bring the water to each unit in the building. On the other hand, the wastewater system will not need pressure because it only needs to move down and out of the building. The wastewater pipe system is provided with vents to allow air in to enable the wastewater to flow down and out more easily. Traps are also present to prevent the wastewater from backing up or returning to where it came from.

For multiple dwelling systems, the freshwater pipe system is basically the same as for single-family homes except that it has several branches, based on the number of units in the building. Specific hot and cold water lines may also be provided. And the drain-waste-vent (DWV) system moves the wastewater out of the building.

In multi-story multifamily dwellings, the main problem is how to provide sufficient pressure for the freshwater to reach every unit. Some buildings employ gravity-based roof tanks. Water is pumped up to the roof tank, which is used to deliver water to every unit using gravity. Other buildings have a series of booster pumps that push the water from storage tanks or from the municipal water supply up to the unit where it is needed.

The team of plumbers from North Texas Plumbing are knowledgeable, trained and experience with regards to the plumbing systems of apartment buildings and multi-family dwellings. They will work closely with the property manager of a building to provide solutions for any tenant plumbing issues that may occur at any time of the day or night.
