Dr. Firestone went on to describe this type of treatment as one that is aimed at removing stubborn surface-based skin lesions, such as plantar warts. The Saorsa wart removal system uses technology that takes full advantage of low-dose microwaves to help get rid of difficult-to-remove plantar warts. He stated that these types of warts are caused by what is known as the human papillomavirus (HPV) virus. They are most associated with the 1, 2, 4, 60, and 63 types of this virus. They are very difficult to remove because plantar

warts project out finger-like roots that tend to grow deep into the skin of the feet. This makes them very hard

to treat using methods that emanate from the surface of the foot.

As a result, Dr. Firestone says they can attack the root cause of plantar warts instead of just attempting to

make patients that suffer from this ailment more comfortable as only those patients? symptoms are treated.

This gives patients a very reasonable chance of having their plantar wart-related problems eliminated or

severely lessened. When the special probed is used in the treatment of plantar warts it does so without

emitting any type of smoke or plume that can be hazardous to the patient, much unlike treatments that use

laser and electrocautery devices.

Using the Saorsa system to remove plantar warts is just one of the many specialized foot and ankle

treatments that their vast network of clinics offers. Other treatments which can be read about on their website
