



North Texas Plumbing Reflects On The Effect Of Inflation On The Cost Of Medical Gas Piping Installation

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Dallas Fort Worth-based medical gas plumber North Texas Plumbing is commenting on what medical gas facilities, that are currently undergoing construction or infrastructure revamps in North Texas, can expect in the coming months following the resurgence in the price of essential raw materials such as copper.

Medical gas plumbing installations are the lifeblood of facilities that provide urgent and long-term medical care to patients suffering from serious or even life-threatening conditions. This includes hospitals, medical offices, health care facilities, emergency rooms, veterinary offices, veterinary surgical centers, operating rooms, and more. A constant uninterrupted supply of medical gases is considered one of the most important tools in the arsenal of licensed medical professionals who work hard to save and improve the lives of their patients.

Medical gas piping installations need to use copper piping due to the chemical composition of the metal which makes it perfectly suited for the task. There are two types of copper plumbing that are used in medical

gas piping setups - Type K which is thicker and heavier and Type L which has a thinner copper wall. Both these types meet the requirements for positive pressure medical gas installation as suggested by the NFPA 99 standard. The NFPA (National Fire Protection Association) 99 standard establishes criteria for levels of health care services or systems based on risk to the patients, staff, or visitors in health care facilities to minimize the hazards of fire, explosion, and electricity. Copper piping is always used to deliver medical-grade gases from a utility room where they are stored in tanks to rooms where they are needed.

Inflation has been at the forefront of every policy and business conversation in public and private enterprises in the country since the start of 2021 when it started rearing its ugly head. Copper prices also swung wildly upwards since the start of the 2020 pandemic to adjust for lower demand due to reduced economic activity. The price of copper in USD per lbs hit its absolute maximum in March 2022. Since the price of the raw material that goes into manufacturing medical gas piping increased dramatically, those expenses greatly inflated the budgets that medical facilities around the country had to accommodate for building or maintaining their infrastructure. Since hitting its 5-year high in March 2022, prices have fallen considerably. In July 2022, it had fallen to the level it was in February 2021. However, the last few months have seen another smaller surge though the price has not risen anywhere close to what it was in March 2022.
