her friends, especially if the privacy settings have not been properly set. Girls who are feeling sad and hopeless are frequently targeted by online predators.?

Online predators may be able to gain vital personal information by pretending to be someone who can offer help. They may be able to get phone numbers, photos, and even the home address of their troubled victims. In addition, sadfishing may also open them up to bullying. Unfortunately, teenage girls are not yet mature enough to understand that not everyone is like them. Instead of being sympathetic, these people may just harass and ridicule the person who is sad and feeling hopeless. A teenage girl already struggling with anxiety or even depression will feel devastated by the bullying.

There are a number of things that parents of teen daughters who are sadfishing can do. First of all, they need to make sure that they are able to see her posts. Second, they need to make her aware that there are online predators and bullies. Third, they should avoid shutting down her social media accounts. Shutting them down will only cause resentment. Fourth, parents should show her where she can safely express her feelings online. There are indeed places online where this can be done, such as private support groups, private messaging friends, and confidential online journals. And fifth, they should try to practice active listening instead of offering advice outright.
