



Hackensack Terroristic Threats Lawyer Adam M. Lustberg Discusses the Laws Surrounding Terroristic Threats in NJ

The lawyer mentions that sometimes, because of emotions, people say things that they should not say. Threats of harm may be taken very seriously in New Jersey. Terroristic threats such as pointing a gun at someone's head or brandishing a knife in someone's direction can be charged with a crime of terroristic threats.

The Hackensack terroristic threats lawyer, "Often, because of the emotions involved between spouses and family members, during an argument that leads to domestic violence, threats of harm may have been issued. Whether you intended to carry out a violent act against the individual or not if your words or actions caused a person to fear that you were going to physically harm them you can be charged with the crime of terroristic threats in New Jersey."

According to the lawyer, if someone is awaiting a case for terroristic threats, they could face severe penalties. A person convicted of a terroristic threat could face 3-5 years in state prison. Terroristic threats may also include bomb threats and shooting threats.

Attorney Adam M. Lustberg says terroristic threats will be filed if someone threatens to commit a violent offense with the intent to terrorize another person or cause evacuation of a building, place or assembly, facility or public transportation, or any other serious inconvenience to the public.

In the article, attorney Lustberg adds, "A person is guilty of a terroristic threats crime of the third degree if he threatens to kill another with the purpose to put him in imminent fear of death under circumstances reasonably causing the victim to believe the immediacy of the threat and the likelihood that it will be carried out."

Terroristic threats can result in a sentence of up to 5 years imprisonment, a fine of up to \$75,000, and a probationary period. If the threats were made in a state of emergency it could be punished with 5-10 years imprisonment, a fine up to \$250,000, and a probationary term.

Lastly, attorney Lustberg emphasizes the importance of having a skilled lawyer when facing terroristic threats charges. Having an experienced attorney may be able to help the defendant protect their freedom and understand their rights in the case.
