These are known as subluxations and can happen all throughout the body, resulting into pain and reduced mobility.

A pinched nerve can be caused by herniated discs or bulging discs, inflamed facet joints, or bone spurs. After determining the cause of the pinched nerve, the chiropractor will determine the best course of treatment, which typically depends on the cause and the location of the pinched nerve. The idea is to relieve the pressure on the nerve and the chiropractor usually does this with manual manipulation, including massage therapy. For pinched nerves due to spine misalignment, the chiropractor can manipulate the bones back into their proper position.
