The consequence is that the root cause of a particular health condition is never found and treated, often resulting in an acute problem becoming a chronic long term condition. Functional Medicine on the other hand looks to treat the whole person by investigating their Total Body Stress Load. This includes the allergic, toxic, infectious, hormonal, and emotional loads a patient is dealing with along with their current diet and nutrition profile.

This can include several different types of functional testing to look into what could be at the root of what's going on. It's an excellent way for trying to get to the source instead of just covering up symptoms."
