As the law firm explains, burglary is split into four degrees. While the specific definitions can vary by jurisdiction, there is a commonality between the four degrees across all jurisdictions. First degree burglary is the most serious degree and usually involves breaking into a dwelling (such as a house or apartment) with the intent to commit a crime (itself often a felony), inside. The presence of people in the dwelling at the time

of the burglary may enhance the severity of the offense. This offense carries a sentence up to 20 years in prison and/or up to a \$35,000 fine; the minimum sentence is six months in the workhouse.

Second degree burglary is often a broader category that includes unlawfully entering various structures, not just dwellings, with the intent to commit a crime within. The conditions under which structures qualify for second degree burglary are if the building is a government, religious, historic, or school building? and the offender enters without consent and either with intent to commit a theft or property damage or commits such a crime. Second degree burglary carries a sentence of up to 10 years in prison and/or up to a \$20,000 fine.

Third degree burglary may follow the act of a building without consent, with intent to steal, commit a felony, commit a gross misdemeanor within (or actually committing such a crime within). The sentence is up to 5 years in prison and/or up to a \$10,000 fine. Finally, the least severe degree is fourth degree burglary, which means entering a building without consent and either with intent to commit a misdemeanor (not stealing, or committing such a crime). The sentence is up to 1 year in prison and/or up to a \$3,000 fine.
