However, it is also important to note that rising damp may still occur in newer buildings as a result of a faulty or non-existent DPC. In such cases, a DPC will have to be installed to stop the rising damp.

Penetrating damp is the result of water getting into the building or property via an external wall. This is primarily due to water entering through a defect in the home or property or when the external stone walls or bricks have deteriorated over time such that they have become porous. This kind of damp is the most common cause of moisture inside a property.

Damp resulting from condensation happens when damp air in the home comes in contact with cold walls, mirrors, windows, etc. This kind of damp may also be found in the corner of rooms and behind and inside furniture. Poor ventilation in the home is frequently the cause of this kind of damp.
