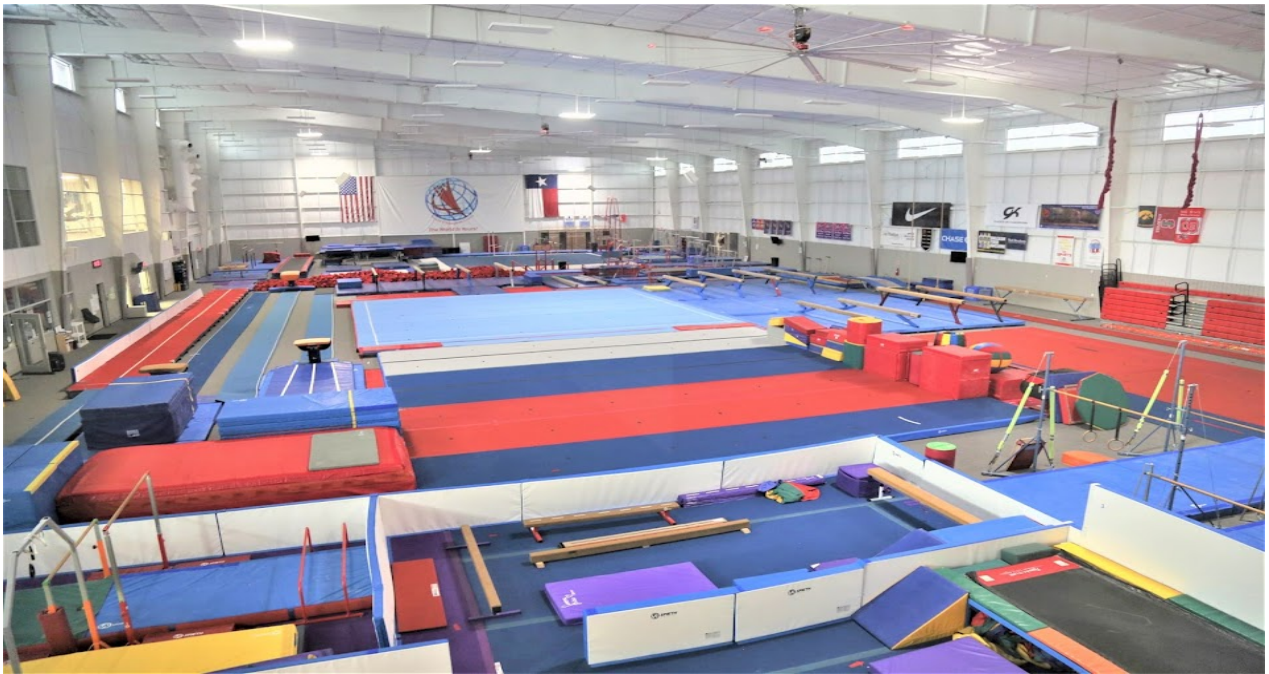




Clinic of Champions at Spring, TX Gymnastics Academy: Elevate One's Skills in World Champions Centre
