"It's golf without the pretense," Bennett adds. "You've got the sophistication of places like Whistling Straits or Kiawah Island, but without the crowds or the waiting list. Tamarack feels like your own personal golf sanctuary in the mountains."

While high-profile resorts like Pinehurst and Sea Island continue to cater to elite travelers, Tamarack's distinction lies in its balanced identity. It is luxurious without being exclusionary, refined yet rooted in community. The resort offers a full range of services including private instruction, equipment rentals, and beginner-friendly programs, alongside luxury lodging, spa access, and locally curated dining.

Tamarack's inclusion in the 2025 Best Golf Resorts US guide places it in elite company, but also distinguishes it for its ethos. Unlike coastal resorts where exclusivity often dominates, Tamarack is built for inclusion, offering tee times for solo travelers, couples, and families alike. Women's clinics, junior programs, and twilight golf social events expand the traditional demographic and invite new players into the sport.

Part of Tamarack's appeal is also logistical: located just two hours from Boise, the resort offers mountain seclusion without sacrificing accessibility. Bennett, who has logged rounds in Arizona's desert terrain and the rolling hills of North Carolina, says Tamarack adds a fresh chapter to American golf travel. "It's not trying to copy what's been done," she explains. "It's carving its own identity, just like the landscape itself."

The visual drama of Tamarack's setting is another key differentiator. Fairways dip and rise against alpine panoramas. Wildlife sightings are common. And in early summer, wildflowers line several holes, adding both beauty and a touch of Idaho wilderness to each round.

The clubhouse further enhances the experience with panoramic terraces, locally-sourced menus, and a pro shop that offers both performance and resort apparel. Special events, such as the resort's "Nine & Dine" summer series or the annual Mountain Open Scramble, attract both residents and destination travelers. Tamarack also offers bundled stay-and-play packages that are gaining popularity with those looking to escape the high prices of Scottsdale or Monterey.

"Tamarack doesn't ask you to be a certain kind of golfer," Bennett notes. "It just asks you to enjoy the game in a beautiful place. That's the kind of energy more courses need."

While Best Golf Resorts US continues to recognize top-tier names like Shadow Creek, The Ocean Course, and Sand Valley, the platform's 2025 outlook puts emphasis on new standards in experience and accessibility.
