"This therapy allows us to support healing at the tissue level without introducing foreign substances or relying on aggressive interventions," said Goodwin. "Patients are looking for results that don't come with the trade-offs of surgery or long-term medication use, and PRP allows us to meet that need with a solution grounded in the patient's biology."

Goodwin explained that PRP therapy is most commonly used to treat chronic joint pain, tendon injuries, ligament sprains, and conditions such as plantar fasciitis, rotator cuff issues, and osteoarthritis. In the chiropractic setting, the therapy is also applied to spine-related concerns, including facet joint inflammation and degenerative disc symptoms, to promote natural tissue healing while supporting structural alignment through traditional chiropractic care.

The clinic takes a comprehensive and individualized approach to evaluating each patient for PRP therapy. Before treatment, patients undergo a thorough consultation and musculoskeletal assessment to determine whether PRP is clinically appropriate. Factors such as injury duration, severity, and overall health status are considered, and treatment plans are developed to incorporate PRP alongside chiropractic adjustments, physical rehabilitation, and therapeutic modalities when needed. This integrative method helps support both short-term relief and long-term recovery.

Goodwin stated that the expansion into regenerative services is part of an ongoing evolution aimed at keeping care responsive to patient needs. While the clinic has built its reputation on chiropractic expertise, its leadership recognized the value of offering biological therapies that could enhance healing without departing from its core principles. "We saw an opportunity to expand our care spectrum while remaining aligned with our foundational approach," said Goodwin. "Patients continue to express interest in options that are proactive and restorative, and PRP is a reflection of that interest."

The procedure itself is performed in-office and typically takes under an hour. After a small blood draw, the sample is processed using a medical centrifuge to concentrate the platelets. The resulting PRP is then injected into the target area under controlled, sterile conditions. Because the therapy uses the patient's biological material, the risk of allergic reaction or infection is extremely low. Patients often return to regular activity within a day, with most reporting improvements in mobility and pain levels over several weeks as the healing response progresses.

While outcomes can vary depending on the individual and the condition being treated, A Family Chiropractic
