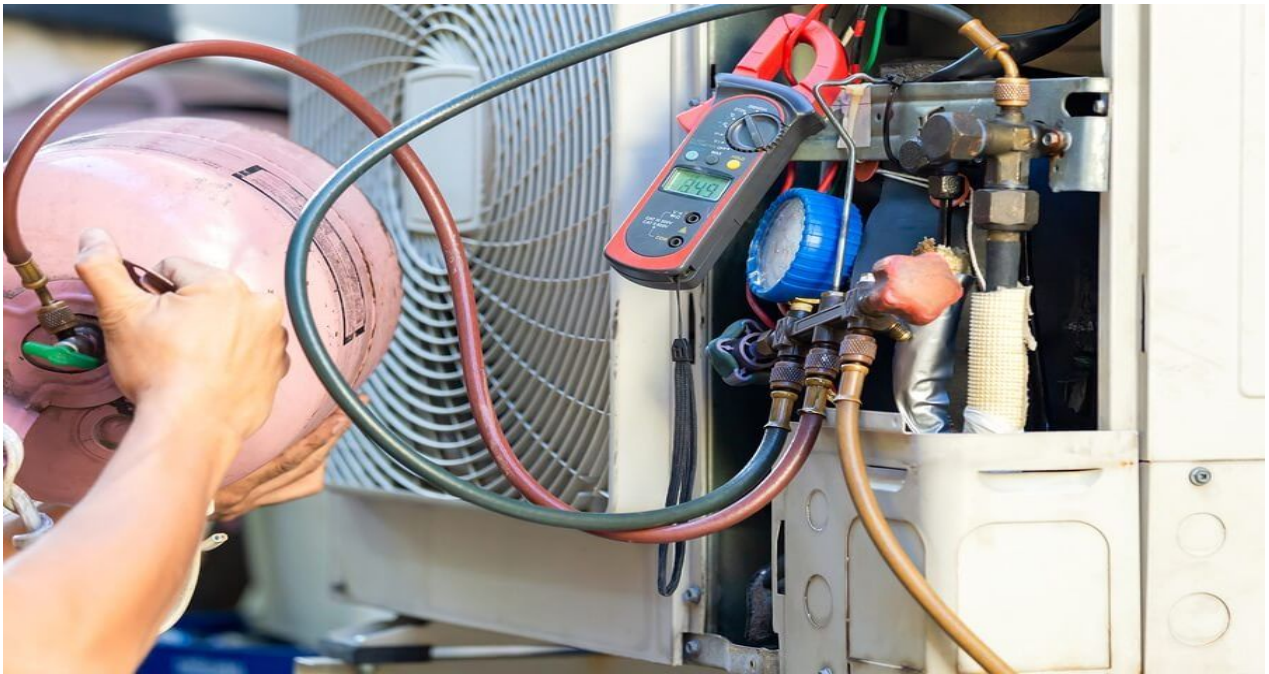




Ingersoll's Refrigeration Air Conditioning & Heating Highlights AC Repair Services Ahead of Summer Cooling Season
