



RestoPros of Intown Atlanta Releases New Guide on HVAC Mold and Summer Air Quality Risks

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RestoPros of Intown Atlanta has published a new homeowner guide detailing how mold develops inside HVAC systems during the region's heavy summer cooling season and how central air conditioning can distribute spores throughout an entire home. The guide arrives alongside a recent summer advisory from the company warning that condensate drain lines commonly clog with algae during periods of sustained air conditioner use, leading to hidden overflow inside ceilings and walls before any visible sign appears.

The guide explains the mechanics behind mold in HVAC systems and air ducts Atlanta homeowners often overlook. Moisture from the evaporator coil, the drip pan, and interior ductwork meets accumulated dust and organic material, creating conditions where mold can take hold. Once colonies form, the air handler pushes spores through supply vents into bedrooms, living areas, and other rooms, spreading contamination well beyond the original source. The company notes that surface cleaning alone rarely resolves the problem because it fails to address the moisture that allows regrowth.

The accompanying summer advisory focuses on a seasonal hazard specific to prolonged cooling demand. As air conditioning units run for extended hours, condensate lines can become blocked by algae buildup. When

drainage backs up, water can overflow into surrounding structures, feeding mold growth in areas that remain out of sight until damage becomes significant.

"Homeowners tend to assume that if the air smells fine and the system is running, everything is healthy," said Averil Magnuson of RestoPros of Intown Atlanta. "In reality, the earliest stages of HVAC mold are almost always invisible. The system keeps circulating air, and spores travel from room to room long before anyone notices a musty odor or sees discoloration around a vent."

The guide outlines the company's approach to Mold remediation Atlanta property owners can expect when a professional team is engaged. The process begins with inspection and moisture mapping, followed by containment, removal of affected material, repair of the moisture source, structural drying, and antimicrobial treatment. Technicians are IICRC certified and follow EPA guidelines, using professional-grade equipment and controlled containment and disposal protocols throughout each project.

"Effective mold remediation Atlanta GA residents can rely on has to treat both the contamination and the cause," Magnuson added. "Removing visible growth without correcting the moisture problem simply resets the clock. The goal is to protect indoor air quality and prevent the issue from returning."
