

Gaskells Waste Services Expands General Waste Collection Operations

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Gaskells Waste Services is highlighting its General Waste Collection service as the company continues to provide scheduled commercial waste management for businesses and organisations across its operating regions. The service supports businesses producing non-recyclable waste, with collection schedules and container arrangements determined according to individual operational requirements.

General waste remains a routine consideration for businesses across sectors including hospitality, retail, education, healthcare, manufacturing and commercial offices. Gaskells Waste Services provides businesses with dedicated containers and scheduled collections, alongside the processing infrastructure required to manage material once it leaves customer premises.

The company currently provides commercial waste collection services to more than 5,000 businesses, schools, events and other organisations. Its general waste operations form part of a wider collection network serving the North West of England, North Wales and Shropshire, with areas covered including Liverpool, Wigan, Manchester, Chester, Warrington, Preston, Wrexham, Bangor, Anglesey and surrounding locations.

Jonathan Gaskell, Managing Director of Gaskells Waste Services, said, "General waste collection is an essential part of day-to-day operations for businesses across many different sectors. Our approach is to understand how much waste an organisation produces, the type of containers it requires and how frequently collections need to take place, allowing an appropriate collection arrangement to be established."

Collection frequency can be adapted according to the volume of waste generated and the location of the customer. Gaskells Waste Services offers daily, weekly and fortnightly collection options where appropriate, with individual schedules discussed as part of the company's assessment of a customer's requirements. Weight data can also be recorded when containers are collected, providing businesses with information about the quantities of waste being produced.

Different container options are available to accommodate variations in waste volume and available storage space. Commercial wheelie bins range from 240 to 1,100 litres, while Front End Loaders provide greater capacity for businesses producing larger quantities of waste. Roll-on roll-off skips are also available for higher-volume commercial and industrial operations, with compaction equipment providing another option where businesses need to manage substantial quantities of material.

An important part of the General Waste Collection service takes place after material has been collected. General waste is transported to Gaskells Waste Services' processing facilities, where automated sorting technology is used to separate recyclable material from the remaining waste stream. Residual material that cannot be recycled can then be baled and sent to Energy from Waste facilities for use as refuse-derived fuel, reducing the quantity of commercial waste ultimately sent to landfill.

The service operates alongside separate collections for recyclable and specialist waste streams. Gaskells Waste Services collects materials including paper, cardboard, food waste, glass, metal and hazardous waste, enabling businesses to establish separate collection arrangements where appropriate rather than placing all material into the general waste stream. The company's Liverpool Materials Recycling Facility and wider processing infrastructure support this approach to separating and recovering materials.

The latest focus on General Waste Collection follows an earlier company announcement outlining Gaskells Waste Services' wider commitment to commercial waste management and recycling. That announcement detailed the development of the family-owned company, its operational infrastructure and its continued investment in waste collection and material recovery. Gaskells Waste Services operates a fleet of more than 30 vehicles, including trade waste, front-end loading, skip and roll-on roll-off vehicles. The company has also invested in its Materials Recycling Facility as part of its infrastructure for processing waste and recovering recyclable material collected from commercial customers.

Commercial organisations in the UK also have a legal Duty of Care concerning the waste they produce, including requirements surrounding its storage and transfer to authorised waste businesses. Gaskells Waste Services states that its collection arrangements are designed to provide businesses of different sizes and sectors with an appropriate system for managing their commercial waste responsibilities.

As businesses continue to review how general and recyclable waste streams are managed, Gaskells Waste Services states that it will continue developing collection arrangements around customer requirements while investing in the vehicles, processing infrastructure and technology supporting its operations.
