



Cutarelli Vision Outlines Cataract Surgery Success Rates in Colorado Springs, Colorado

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Cutarelli Vision, an ophthalmology practice in Colorado Springs, Colorado, has published a patient resource examining cataract surgery success rates, complication data, and lens technology for residents who are evaluating the procedure across the region. The practice provides cataract surgery, premium intraocular lens implantation, and intraoperative aberrometry at its Colorado Springs office on Austin Bluffs Parkway. The article, titled Cataract Surgery Colorado Springs, reviews national outcome benchmarks alongside the credentials, technology, and surgeon experience that patients can weigh when comparing cataract surgeons in the area.

According to the resource, cataract surgery carries a high overall success rate, with clinical studies showing that 95 percent or more of patients achieve 20/40 or better corrected vision and that many reach 20/20 vision when premium intraocular lenses are used. The 20/40 standard is the level of vision required to drive without glasses in Colorado. Patients throughout Colorado Springs and the wider Front Range who are considering cataract surgery have access to premium intraocular lenses, including trifocal, extended-depth-of-focus, and light-adjustable options that can reduce dependence on glasses after surgery. The article reports that final visual acuity depends on each patient's overall eye health and the lens that is selected.

Published clinical data cited in the article indicates that serious complications from cataract surgery occur in roughly 1 to 2 percent of procedures and are most often treatable when identified early. The cataract surgery program at the Colorado Springs office incorporates ORA (Optiwave Refractive Analysis) intraoperative aberrometry, which measures the eye during surgery to guide lens selection, along with premium lens implants and dropless cataract surgery. The resource notes that cataract surgery is performed on an outpatient basis under topical anesthesia, that most patients experience minimal discomfort, and that the procedure typically takes about 15 to 20 minutes per eye, with many patients resuming normal activities within a day or two.

Beyond cataract surgery, Cutarelli Vision provides LASIK, PRK, and refractive lens exchange (RLE) to patients in Denver, Fort Collins, and the Boulder Valley area, the practice's three other Colorado Front Range locations. The article explains that cataract surgery removes the eye's clouded natural lens and replaces it with an artificial intraocular lens selected for the patient's vision needs, and that it is the only treatment that removes a cataract rather than compensating for early visual decline. Common cataract symptoms described in the resource include cloudy or hazy sight, glare and halos around lights, faded color perception, and increasing difficulty seeing at night or while driving after dark.

The article also outlines how patients can verify a surgeon's qualifications, noting that board certification through the American Board of Ophthalmology indicates a surgeon has completed accredited residency training and passed written and oral examinations, and that certification can be confirmed through the board's records and Colorado state medical board records. Surgeon volume is identified as one of the stronger predictors of cataract surgery outcomes, with higher procedure volume associated with lower complication rates. Cataract procedures at Cutarelli Vision are performed by Dr. Paul Cutarelli, who has completed more than 90,000 vision correction procedures since 1995 and finished his ophthalmology residency at the Wilmer Eye Institute at Johns Hopkins Hospital and a corneal fellowship at Moorfields Eye Hospital in London.

"With more than 90,000 vision correction procedures performed since 1995, careful preoperative screening and lens selection are central to how we approach cataract surgery," said Dr. Paul Cutarelli, MD, a Johns Hopkins-trained, board-certified corneal specialist and founder of Cutarelli Vision. "Matching the right intraocular lens to each patient's corneal measurements and lifestyle is what allows many patients to reduce their dependence on glasses after surgery." Cutarelli Vision reports an over 95 percent success rate across its vision correction services and is a surgeon-owned and operated practice rather than a corporate chain.

Cutarelli Vision is located at 7615 Austin Bluffs Parkway, Unit 210, in Colorado Springs, Colorado, and serves patients throughout Colorado Springs, Denver, Fort Collins, and the Boulder Valley area. The practice reports that patients travel from across the country for cataract surgery and other vision correction procedures performed in Colorado Springs, and it offers free cataract consultations at the Colorado Springs office.
