



Crusaders Fence Urges Fall Scheduling Before Winter Ground Freeze

CULPEPER, VA - August 11, 2026 -

Crusaders Fence, a licensed and insured fence installation company serving Central Virginia, is encouraging homeowners to schedule fence projects this fall, before winter freeze-thaw cycles make setting posts in the region's clay soil harder and slower.

The timing matters because of how the ground behaves once temperatures drop. The 2021 Virginia Residential Code sets the frost line for the Fredericksburg area at 18 inches, the depth at which soil begins to freeze in winter. Crusaders Fence sets posts below that line and anchors them in high-strength concrete, so a finished fence stays plumb once the cold arrives. A post that reaches past the frost line keeps stable, unfrozen earth gripping its base through the season, which is what stops a fence from lifting or leaning after a hard winter. Central Virginia's red clay adds a second factor. Clay swells when it takes on water and shifts as it freezes and thaws, and that movement is what pushes shallow or poorly set posts out of line over a few seasons.

Fall scheduling gets ahead of both issues. Soil across the region usually stays workable well into the season, which lets crews auger clean post holes and pour footings before the first hard freeze. Booking in autumn also sidesteps the spring rush, when the first warm weeks send fence requests climbing and stretch out lead times for everyone waiting. A project started now is typically finished and settled long before that backlog forms. Crusaders Fence launched in 2025 and holds Virginia contractor license number 2705197740. Founder Conall Finn has spent more than 10 years in the fencing trade, and the company is accredited by the Better Business Bureau through its Richmond, VA chapter.

Beyond the timing, the company handles the paperwork that can otherwise stall a fence project. Crusaders Fence files permits, manages homeowners association approvals, and coordinates VA811 utility marking, the state service that locates buried gas, water, and electrical lines before any digging begins. County rules differ across the Fredericksburg region, and matching a fence to the local setback and height limits is part of the pre-installation work. Homeowners receive a written estimate on the spot during the first visit, with pricing itemized line by line, and most residential fences are installed in one to two days.

For families weighing the project, a fall build also means the fence is standing before spring, when the yard gets the most use. Finishing the work in the slower months removes the wait that often comes with a warm-weather start, when demand across the trade is at its highest.

"People assume fencing is a spring job, and the good months slip past while they wait," said Conall Finn, founder and licensed fence contractor of Crusaders Fence, LLC. "The ground here is still easy to work in October, and I would rather set a post in fall soil than fight frozen clay in January. A fence that goes in now is finished and standing before anyone is thinking about their yard again."
