



American Cornhole Organization Concludes ACO World Cornhole Championships for Season 21

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The American Cornhole Organization has completed the ACO World Championships of Cornhole for Season 21, held at the Owensboro Convention Center in Owensboro, Kentucky. The multi-day event brought together competitors from across the country and around the world to determine the top players across the organization's sanctioned divisions.

As the official governing body for the sport since 2005, the ACO Worlds 21 American Cornhole Organization event marked the culmination of a full season of tournament play. Competitors earned their places through the ACO Majors Tour and other points-earning tournaments held throughout the year, with world standings determining the field that arrived in Owensboro for the championship rounds.

The ACO Season 21 championships featured competition across multiple divisions, including professional play, state and regional qualifiers, and the ACO Tailgator Division for backyard competitors. Matches were contested under the official rules of the sport, which the organization maintains and which are followed by

cornhole players worldwide.

Beyond the competitive brackets, the championship week was structured as an ACO Worlds 21 Family Fun gathering, offering spectators of all ages an opportunity to experience the sport in person. The event combined high-level competition with a community atmosphere that has become a hallmark of the organization's flagship gatherings.

Frank Geers, Founder of the American Cornhole Organization, noted that Season 21 reflected the continued growth of the sport. "Owensboro provided an outstanding setting for this year's championships, and the level of play across every division showed how far the sport has come since 2005," Geers said. "Bringing players and families together in one venue to compete under the official cornhole rules is what the World Championships have always been about."

Coverage of the tournament was made available beyond the convention center as well. Through the organization's broadcast platforms, ACO Cornhole Worlds 21 Live 24/7 streaming allowed fans who could not attend in person to follow featured matches and highlights from the event. The organization has built a growing library of tournament footage, including live streams and full match replays from its major events throughout the season.

The conclusion of the Season 21 championships closes one competitive year while setting the stage for the next. World standings established across the season's tournaments, culminating in Owensboro, reflect the performance of top players across each division of the sport.

The American Cornhole Organization is the official worldwide governing body for the sport of cornhole and has operated since 2005. Headquartered in Camp Dennison, Ohio, the organization sanctions tournaments at local, state, regional, and world levels, including the ACO Majors Tour, the ACO Pro Series of Cornhole, the ACO Skins Pro Division, and the ACO Adaptive Cornhole Division. The organization maintains the official rules of the sport, publishes world standings, offers memberships that connect players to a worldwide community, and provides certified equipment and gear. The organization also partners with bag manufacturers to supply approved equipment for its sanctioned events.
