The firm handles Chapter 7, Chapter 11, and Chapter 13 cases. Chapter 7, often used by low to moderate income individuals, can eliminate most or all unsecured debt for those who qualify. Chapter 13 allows a debtor to restructure payments into a more manageable plan, after which most remaining unsecured debts are discharged. The firm also assists with debt settlement, student loan matters, wage garnishment, foreclosure, car repossession, and medical debt. The filing process typically begins with locating a qualified bankruptcy lawyer in Elizabethton, followed by gathering financial documents, completing the means test, meeting with an approved credit counselor, and submitting the required forms. The current cost to file for bankruptcy in Elizabethton is \$335, which may be paid in installments in certain circumstances.

"Every financial situation is different, and the right chapter depends on the individual circumstances of each person," the spokesperson added. "Providing clear guidance early in the process helps clients make informed decisions about their financial future."
